Journaling Brainstorms

- “Top 10 about fall”
 - Pictures / pages of each
- Do you do anything special during fall? (corn field mazes, berry picking, hayrides)
 - Pictures of activities
- Do you / your child like jumping in / raking the leaves?
 - Pictures raking / jumping in leaves
- How does the change in seasons make you feel? Do you like the changing leaves?
 - Pictures of your home in fall (changing leaves, fall decorations)
- Do you carve pumpkins? Who does the carving?
 - Pictures of carving, carver and finished pumpkins
- Describe the smells, sounds, sights of fall
- Does fall bring any special foods (apple pie, ham, caramel apples, canning, pumpkin seeds)
 - Include a family / favorite recipe
- Have your child / loved one draw a picture / write what fall means to them or their own “top 3” – include it in your album
- Are you happy to see the start of school? What are any special activities you do to prepare? (school clothes shopping, special lunch dates)

 - Pictures of first day of school, front of school
 - Have your child write their name and include it in your album
