## Journaling Brainstorms

- “Top 5-10” about the air show
  - Pictures / pages of each favorite
- Describe the sights and sounds and how they make you feel (the planes flying overhead, the vibration on the ground etc)
  - Picture
- What do you think when you see that man has created something so powerful?
- Did you do anything special before / after (lunch, toy)
  - Pictures of activities
- Did you children call the Air Show or planes anything special? (For example, we call all C-130s Fat Albert)
  - Picture of the planes / front of Air Show
- Were your children scared, excited? Did they scream, cry, squeal?
  - Picture of the excitement / expression they expressed
- Is the Air Show a tradition or was this a one time outing?
  - Pictures of your child at the show in previous years along side pictures in present
- Did you purchase any souvenirs? How was that souvenir chosen? How much did it cost? How did you child carry it / what did they do with it? (Sleep, eat, pretend fly)
  - Picture of child with souvenir
- What is each family members’ favorite plane and why?
  - Picture of member with plane or at Air Show
- Have your child draw a picture – include it in your album
- Keep the receipt from the transaction of ticket sales or souvenir purchases
